

RESOLUTION NO. 091520-1105

A RESOLUTION OF THE BROOKS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS IN SUPPORT OF A NOVEMBER 3, 2020 BALLOT ITEM REGARDING THE SAN ANTONIO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT 2020 BONDS TOTALING 1.3 BILLION DOLLARS; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Independent School District (SAISD) is proposing two bond propositions totaling \$1.3 billion that will be on the November 3, 2020 ballot; and

WHEREAS, the first bond proposal, known as Proposition A, is proposing \$1.2 billion to go toward renovation for 36 campuses, safety upgrades for all of the district's more than 90 campuses, and the replacement of aging chillers; and

WHEREAS, the second bond proposal, known as Proposition B, is proposing \$90 million to be allocated toward technology upgrades at the district's more than 90 campuses; and

WHEREAS, the proposed bonds seek to address infrastructure needs throughout SAISD that have historically not been addressed properly and are imperative to the success of the district's students; and

WHEREAS, in addition to proposed renovations, the SAISD bonds include plans for expansion of the Centers for Applied Science and Technology (CAST) Med High School, located on the Brooks campus, to properly accommodate additional students and faculty expected to near 1,000; and

WHEREAS, the Brooks Vision and Mission for FY2019–2023, adopted by the Brooks Board of Directors are as follows:

- Brooks Vision: A San Antonio community attracting local, national, and international investment to achieve world-class opportunities that transform the campus, surrounding neighborhoods and the region while respecting our rich and vibrant history.
- Brooks Mission: Our mission is to promote and develop a vibrant, sustainable community that serves as a catalyst for progressive economic development and regional prosperity.

WHEREAS, supporting additional funding for SAISD, which serves the Brooks campus, its surrounding area, and all of San Antonio, falls directly in line with the Brooks Mission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE BROOKS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION OF RECITALS. The Brooks Development Authority Board hereby finds that the statements set forth in the recitals of this Resolution are true and correct, and the City hereby incorporates such recitals as findings of fact as an integral part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. The Brooks Development Authority Board of Directors expresses its support of the San Antonio Independent School District 2020 Bonds.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately following its passage.
